Greetings friends!

When I was in elementary school, my mother used to play tapes and CDs of contemporary Christian music in the car and at home. She convinced my dad to take my sister and I with them to attend concerts with headliners like Carman, Sandi Patti, the Gaithers...and Ray Boltz.

Ray Boltz...I remember my mom had a secret crush on him in the early 90s. His iconic mullet perm with mustache reminded me of Tom Selleck...and a cocker spaniel! But that man could sing the gospel with a voice like an angel! In 1988, Roy Boltz wrote the song "Thank You" to testify of God's power to transform lives through the generosity of faithful Christians in their stewardship.

The essence of the song's lyrics is that the singer dreams he goes to heaven with a friend. As they walk, the people approach his friend and tell stories of how, unknowingly, he had impacted their lives. Each person says thank you to him for his gifts and service through which their lives were forever changed. After each story the chorus rings out these words, "Thank you for giving to the Lord. I am a life that was changed. Thank you for giving to the Lord. I am so glad you gave."

One of the verses sings, "One by one they came, far as the eye could see. Each life somehow touched by your generosity. Little things that you had done, sacrifices made, unnoticed on the earth in heaven, now proclaimed." The point of the song is that we serve and give here on earth never knowing the outcome of how our giving has impacted the lives of others--until eternity. What we find is that even small sacrifices result in huge impacts upon furthering the Kingdom.

On Consecration Sunday, as we give our tithes and offerings, and dedicate our stewardship to God for 2020, remember that every gift helps the church make a difference. We are impacting lives here in our community and around the world. We can do what we do as a local church because of your generosity.

While the song "Thank you" by Ray Boltz was born from his imagination, I hope and believe that heaven will be filled with stories of what gifts like yours will have meant to countless millions of people. I invite you to enter into a moment of silence today, and reflect on those whose generosity has impacted your life and give thanks to God for them. Now, hear God's Word for you today:

17 All shall give as they are able, according to the blessing of the Lord your God that he has given you.

Proverbs 22:9 (NRSV)

9 Those who are generous are blessed, for they share their bread with the poor.

2 Corinthians 9:7 (NRSV)

7 Each of you must give as you have made up your mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

1 Timothy 6:17-19 (NRSV)

17 As for those who in the present age are rich, command them not to be haughty, or to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but rather on God who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. 18 They are to do good, to be rich in good works, generous, and ready to share, 19 thus storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of the life that really is life.

I pray that your church's giving in 2020 will resound in heaven like churches were singing in 1990!
