A person can also give up a bad habit for Lent and in doing so it might become a life changing experience. My prayer and hope for all of you this Lenten season is to become closer to Jesus.

I hope to see as many of you that can make it to the Lenten Soup and Devotion time each Wednesday during Lent starting on March 4th at noon. Also to the Lenten Bible study on Wednesday nights starting March 4th at 6pm or Thursday mornings starting March 5th at 1030am.


In recent years, UMCOR has impacted relief efforts around the world including:
