Crawford appointed Spoon River District Superintendent

GALESBURG – Bishop Frank J. Beard, in consultation with the Spoon River District Committee on Superintendency has appointed the Rev. Michael J. Crawford as district superintendent, effective July 1.

Crawford will succeed the Rev. Stephen Granadosin, who along with his wife, Cecilia, are planning to relocate to Texas to be near family. Both were appointed to their current sites of ministry in 2017 – Stephen to the Spoon River District superintendency and Cecilia – to Peoria: Forrest Hill UMC.



"Rev. Mike Crawford has proven himself to be a very valuable member of the IGRC leadership team and has excelled in his work as the Coordinator of Congregational Development," said Bishop Beard in making the announcement. "Rev. Crawford is a forward thinker with tremendous skills of strategic planning and insight. He has assisted the Cabinet for the past two years as our coordinator/implementor of Strength Finders. Strength Finders is used in the appointment process to match pastors and churches. Reverend Crawford's work in this area over the last two years has given him experience with the Cabinet and the Extended Cabinet."

Bishop Beard also noted, "Rev. Crawford has analytical assessment skills and a wealth of experiences that have proven to be significantly valuable to the Cabinet. I appreciate the hard work ethic, the commitment to integrity, and the openness to explore new and emerging ideas." Crawford spoke of the role the Conference has played in his faith and ministry.

"The Illinois Great Rivers Conference has done much to nurture my faith and that of our family," he said. "We have come to know IGRC as our 'home church.' I hope through my serving IGRC churches in this role that I can encourage churches to live into God's call for their next season of ministry."

Working closely with the Congregational Development Committee, the IGRC Personnel Committee will begin a search process for the next Coordinator of Congregational Development.

Bishop Beard has also announced that Rev. Crawford's installation will be a part of the Opening Worship at the 2022 Annual Conference at 10 a.m. June 9. "I am thrilled about his appointment and welcome him as a full member of the IGRC appointive Cabinet."

Mike Crawford

Crawford, 61, is a graduate of Staunton High School and Trinity College in Deerfield where he received his bachelor's degree in Biblical Studies and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School.

He has served as pastor of Mineral, Owaneco-Buckeye, associate at Galesburg: First, co-pastor with his wife, Patty Johansen at Rochester and at East Moline: Christ. He was appointed Acting Director of Congregational Development Jan. 16, 2003, later a part-time consultant with Congregational Development and two years as associate director of congregational development before assuming the role of Coordinator of Congregational Development July 1, 2006.

His wife, Patty Johansen, currently pastor of Quincy: Vermont Street UMC, will be retiring July 1. They are the parents of two grown children, Kara and Mark Crawford (wife: Andrea), pastor of Onarga-Gilman-Ashkum UMC's; and grandparents of 5 ½-month-old Levi Rios Crawford.


Mother's Day Service

Tuesday morning Bible Study is starting a new study on May 10th at 10AM.

We will be reading *Making Sense of the Bible* by Adam Hamilton. This 6 week study will meet each Tuesday at 10AM.

Summary:

Denominations from evangelical to mainline continue to experience deep divisions over universal social issues. The underlying debate isn't about a particular social issue, but instead it is about how we understand the nature

of scripture and how we should interpret it. The world's bestselling, most-read, and most-loved book is also one of the most confusing. In *Making Sense of the Bible, Adam Hamilton, one of the country's leading pastors and Christian authors, addresses the hot-button issues that plague the church and cultural debate, and answers many of the questions frequently asked by Christians and non-Christians alike.*

Did God really command Moses to put gay people to death? Did Jesus really teach that everyone who is not a Christian will be assigned to hell? Why would Paul command women to "keep silent in the church?" Were Adam and Eve real people? Is the book of Revelation really about the end times? Who decided which books made it into the scriptures and why? Is the Bible ever wrong? In approachable and inviting language, Hamilton addresses these often misunderstood biblical themes leading readers to a deeper appreciation of the Bible so that we might hear God speak through it and find its words to be life-changing and life-giving.


